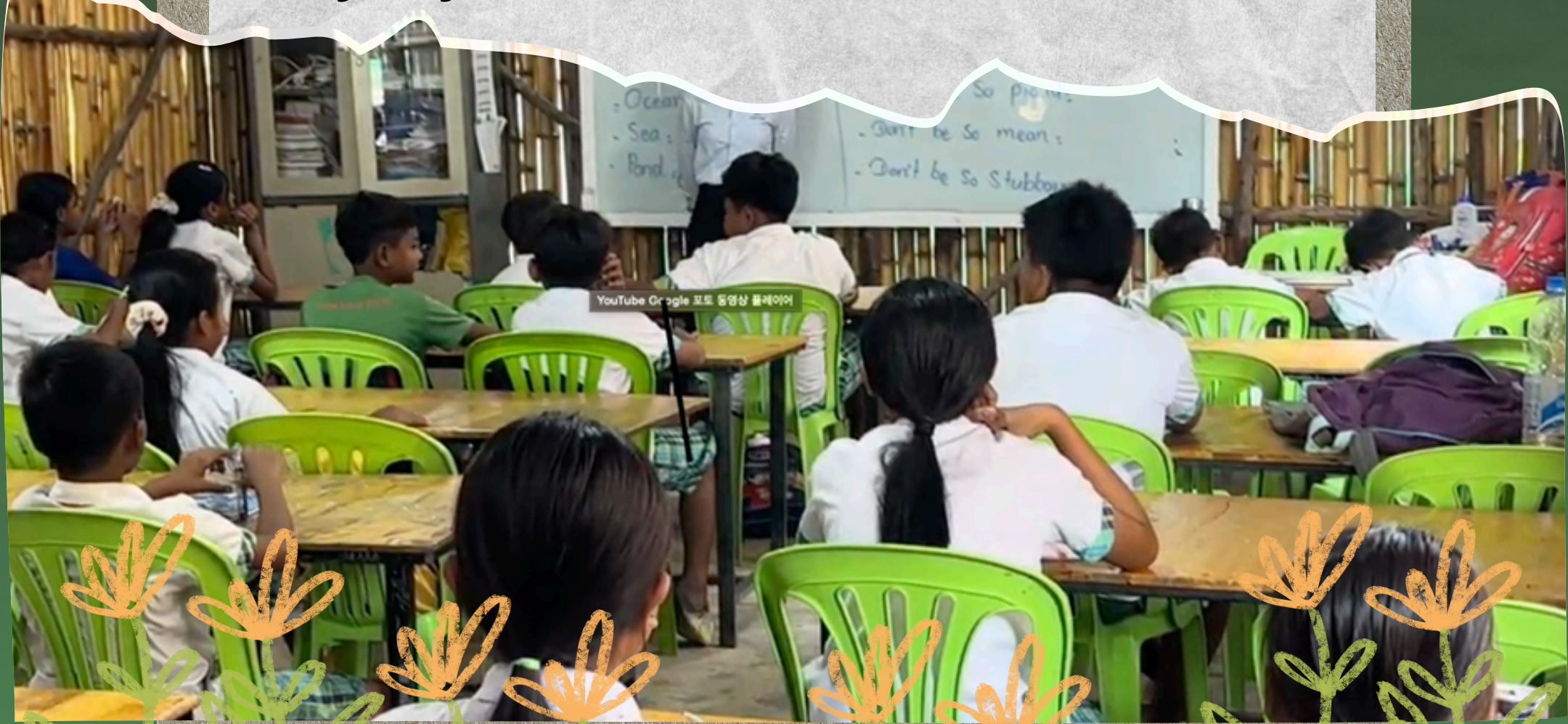




## Green Bethel March News Update

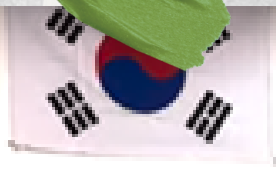
## After-School Programs
